2010 ALL – STAR PARENT COMMITMENT LETTER

When a child is selected as an All-Star, it is a great accomplishment. Along with that, comes a great deal of responsibility and commitment. The All-Star Season shall run from May 3, 2010 through July 15, 2010. Teams will be competing in a minimum of four (4) tournaments, which can include games on Friday, Saturday & Sunday. In addition to the tournaments, most coaches will hold four (4) to six (6) practices a week. It is of utmost importance, to the team, that all players are able to make a FULL COMMITMENT to the entire season. This includes practices and tournaments. The fee to participate on an All-Star Team is \$175.00, per player. In addition, each team is responsible and required to obtain a \$200.00 Team Sponsor. Should the team NOT obtain a sponsor, the team shall be responsible for the sponsorship fee. If this fee is not received by MVGSA prior to the beginning of the second tournament, the team will not be entered into any further tournaments, until the fee is paid. These funds are important, as they help defray the cost of uniforms and tournament entry fees. MVGSA shall furnish each player with an All-Star uniform. The uniform shall consist of a visor, numbered jersey, shorts and socks. Any other items shall be purchased separately and at the cost of the player.

Each player must have a parent work two (2) hours, at the MVGSA Summer Bash Tournament. MVGSA will require a \$100.00 (one-hundred dollar) deposit from all parents. All deposits will be held and NOT deposited, if the parent fulfills their time allotment. Should the parent NOT fulfill the their time allotment, MVGSA WILL DEPOSIT THE \$100.00. ~NO EXCEPTIONS~

*Please be aware that it is of utmost importance that you, as the parent, understand that if your child is selected as an MVGSA All-Star Player, it **DOES NOT** guarantee your child playing time during Championship Play in any ASA Tournament(s), to include ASA District, State and National Tournaments ONLY. The All-Star Playing Rule, as it pertains to playing time (Each player shall play a minimum of one (1) defensive inning, within the first four (4) innings), shall apply and be in full force and effect, during all other tournaments.*

PARENT CONDUCT

1. **MVGSA will not tolerate any behavior, on the playing field or in the stands, that would hinder, or cause to hinder, the spirit of good sportsmanship and cooperation, of which, we are trying to encourage.**
2. **At NO time shall MVGSA permit, or condone, foul and/or abusive language, in the vicinity of any team event.**
3. **No alcoholic beverages or smoking is permitted in the vicinity of any team event.**
4. **The conduct, of any guest(s), is the responsibility of the adult whose child participates on an MVGSA All-Star Team.**
5. **MVGSA Disciplinary Policy shall be enforced for all Coaches, Players & Parents.**
